
Re: Town Line Perambulation

Dear Mr. Nutter:

Enclosed please find the original and one copy of the report as requested. At a subsequent survey Mr. Keller and Mr. Clough located a stone bound in the woods just south of the Shirley Cut-off so called. This is a prominent stone about 9' X 9' X 5' high and marked with an L - 1878, 20, 27 and noted in the former perambulations.

The Alton Planning Board contacted the New Durham Planning Board relative to roadway names of those roads crossing the town line. As noted in the enclosed reports the roadways bear differing names and it would be helpful to simplify this matter.
