

PERAMBULATION OF TOWN LINE  
BETWEEN  
ALTON, N. H. AND NEW DURHAM, N. H.

On Saturday, November 19, 1983, Selectmen from the 5 towns, Alton, Barnstead, Strafford, Farmington and New Durham met to view and verify "the 5 Corners" common point of the 5 towns. It was as described in the 1975 perambulation.

On Friday December 9, 1983 Selectman Mandon Bates of New Durham and Selectman George Shaw of Alton met and proceeded to perambulat the Alton-New Durham boundry.

Beginning at the "5 corners" bound previously viewed, we checked the markers on Cook Road (Meaderboro Road), Muchado Hill Road (Ten Rod Road), Prospect Mountain Road (Ridge Road), Stockbridge Road, Shirley Cut-off and found them to be as described.

The markers on Route 11 and Old Bay Road have been replaced as suggested by 4" square cement posts and marked.

We were unable to locate the marker at Jones Pond (Marsh Pond) because of the snow.


The markers at Marsh Hill Road and Chesley Road can not be located as previously mentioned.

There also is no marker at crossing of Rines Road (Caverly Road) and this should be verified.

The common corner marker of Alton, New Durham and Wolfboro was not observed because of the weather. The previous discription seems to ~~indemnify~~ this point clearly.
