Boodey Farmstead Committee Sept. 25, 2017

Present: Cathy Orlowicz, Tatiana Cicuto, Fran Frye, Sherry Cullimore, and Cecile Chase, Selectman, (for a short while).

The meeting started at 6pm, in the Conference Room located in Town Hall.

Fran made the motion to accept the minutes of the Sept. 18, 2017 meeting, as presented. Tatiana seconded the motion and the vote to accept was unanimous, in favor.

Our balance from the bookkeeper is \$15,374.70 which exactly matches our records! This sum includes the \$885.00 made from the Italian dinner.

We are to pose some questions for discussion at our next meeting. This will be so that we can respond effectively to any questions we are asked.

We will ask for a joint meeting with the Boodey Farmstead Committee, Meeting House Committee and the Board of Selectmen. Since we are all working toward the same goal to preserve our history and make the information available to the public it seems a good idea.

Saturday, Sept. 30, 2017 Annavitte Rand, a UNH Independent Study candidate, will meet with us at 2pm at Town Hall. We will visit the original Boodey House site on the Ridge and the new location on Berry Road.
