### 4. Review of Documents

- NH RSA 674:5-8, was read by Chairman Drummey. Scott asked for "clarity on whether the CIP Advisory Committee was formed via the local legislative process or appointment by a capital committee. Nicole Zoltko, New Durham Town Administrator provided clarity and cited approval of a 2007 Warrant Article (25), establishing the CIP as a subcommittee of the Planning Board.
- CRF/ETF Account Info. (MS 9) report was furnished to the committee. A question was asked if the figures included approved warrants. It was noted that necessary updates will be included in the review process.
- 2023-2032 CIP Report was furnished to the committee and reviewed. Nicole informed the committee that
  this report was also furnished to all departments asking them to update and provide input to the committee for
  inclusion to the 2024-2033 report.

# 5. Goals and Objectives:
