WANTS:

- The current facility lacks an emergency operation center, a radio room, and proper decontamination area
- The new facility would include ALL of the above concerns plus:
 - Additional bay to house the fire apparatus properly
 - Areas for proper storage of equipment
 - o Dispatch office would be for the Fire, Police and Highways departments

OBSERVATIONS:

- The building is old and needs to be replaced (this has been an ongoing topic since 2004)
- Cosmetic maintenance issues are visible and notably high readings of carcinogens within the structure
- Informed that we have several Fire vehicles that will coming due for replacement, on a back to back schedule
- We also learned that the New Durham Fire department provides Mutual Aid with the surrounding areas and the reciprocal agreement has worked well for ALL
