#### **Review of Wetland and Shoreland Applications**

Wetlands Permit Application by Notification – Field, Map 103/Lot 21, 12 Owls Head Rd. Application for replacement of seasonal dock, specifically concrete pad dock anchor due to deterioration in same location. Guidance to applicants is that even with request for permit by notification, applicants should be notified that they will require approval by full Commission under normal circumstances.

Mr. Gehl previously approved the Application on behalf of the Commission. Motion for ratification of Mr. Gehl's prior approval made by Ms. Freeman, seconded by Mr. Sullivan. Unanimously approved.

Shoreland Permit Application – Glenny, Map 116/Lot 13, 208 South Shore Rd. Application to replace existing dwelling and garage with marginal increase of impermeable surface from 18.9% to 19.6% total and removed from the shoreline. Mr. Sullivan recused himself from consideration of this matter. No zoning or planning board issues were noted.
