Meeting called to order at 1:14pm

Secretary's report was read and accepted with corrections made

Treasurer's report was approved

Paula and Rick Pero talked about the Little Free Library they installed at the clubhouse.

Pat Grant mentioned adding a latch to the door in case of high winds.

### Water

Pumps lost pressure on the 25th

Corey Bisson, Jake Dawson, and Jake's men found the leak on Friday morning.

We need to contact those on the system and request, that if they are going to be here seasonally, that they shut off their water when they leave. Good idea for vacationers during the winter as well.

Jake will also look in to the parts for the lower pump and the check valve that is malfunctioning.

Due to the design set-up, and the malfunction, the pumps appear to have damage.

It was mentioned that there is no throttle in the pump at the clubhouse. Nick Sceggell from Dubois and King was one of the designers, so he may be a good person to consult.

### Clean Up Day

Two truckloads went to the dump.

It was noted that the back breaks on the truck aren't operational and that we need to get the truck inspected if we are to use it again.
