Agenda Points:

- **TRUCK**
 - Plow truck windshield needs replacing.

- **PARKING and STORAGE AREA**
 - Trailer/boat parking are not to be returned to space once they are removed.
 - Cones are not to be moved once in place
 - Illegal Parking during the winter causing issues
 - No Overnight parking in front of the Lodge without permission

- **POSTING BOARD PLANS**
 - Rick Pero to work with commissioners on building and set ups
 - One at St. Moritz road entrance and one by the club house
- **BROKEN WATER SHUT OFF**
 - Mat to repair broken water shut off on lower Mountain Drive
- **TREE REMOVAL**
 - 603 Tree Care will work on pruning and removing dead trees at the entrance of Mountain Drive. Scheduling will be based around bus pickup and drop off
- **CULVERTS**
 - Are a priority, some homes have no culverts and drainage this time of the year is backing up
 - Data was collected on missing, blocked, damaged culverts
 - Homeowners are ultimately responsible for the maintenance and repair/replace
 - Do what you can to facilitate flow of your culvert that runs under your driveway

- Keep trees/leaves/dead limbs/and litter clear from your culverts
- **HOUSES AND 911 NUMBERS**
 - To ensure the 911 Response Team finds your home in an emergency, properties should have visible house numbers attached to the house AND the end of driveways. Winter snow may obscure driveway numbers
- **Abutting Copple Crown Lots**
 - Looking into legal advice on how and when we can make available to abutters
- **LIENS; WATER; STORAGE FEES; CULVERT FINES**
 - In Contact with Dave Scanlon the Secretary of State as to how to implement
 - CCVD is willing to work with the few residents having issues if they contact 2015CCVD@gmail.com and work with the commissioners
