All driveway culverts need to be cleared for better drainage. Please do not rake or blow leaves into drainage ditches. Residents on Franconia and Mountain Drive may need driveway culverts installed by next year to continue ditch improvements.

The commissioners have hired a lawyer to gather CCDV asset information, which is the first step in information gathering in the dissolution inquiry.

Applications are on the town's website for boat parking. The fee is \$100 for the year.

Pat Grant asked if we had completed the sale of lot 100 on Mountain Drive to Melisa Gylfphe. The commissioners are working with the town and a realtor to make sure everything is done right.
