

Charitable Organizations in Town of New Durham Approval for Raffle Permits Policy

In accordance with RSA 287-A:7, any charitable organization desiring to conduct a raffle under the provisions of that chapter must first obtain a permit from the New Durham Board of Selectmen if the raffle drawing is held within New Durham.

The Board of Selectmen hereby designates the Town Administrator, per RSA 287-A: 7, to issue permits to charitable organizations desiring to conduct a raffle. A copy of every permit issued shall be made for Board of Selectmen, the Town Clerk, the organization filing and the Police Department for record keeping purposes.

- Raffle tickets shall be sold only to persons 16 years of age or over.
- Only members of the organization or an individual authorized by the organization shall sell tickets.
- No one shall receive financial remuneration for selling tickets.
- All raffle tickets shall be printed with the name of the charitable organization, the
 date and place of the drawing, the prize or prizes to be awarded and the amount of
 the donation.
- The Permit shall expire at the time of the drawing and shall not be transferable.
- At the request of the charitable organization to conduct more than one raffle, the Board of Selectmen may extend the permit to one year from the date of issuance.
