TOWN OF NEW DURHAM ROAD MAINTENANCE POLICY

The safety and welfare of the residents and travelers of the Town of New Durham is the primary concern of the Board of Selectmen and the Road Agent.

It is the policy of the Town of New Durham to provide for and maintain the safe conditions of the town-maintained roads, as reasonably as possible regardless of whether they be paved or gravel.

Year round, Town officials and employees are committed to maintaining the Town's Class V roads (Town maintained roads) in a passable state within the conditions at hand and within budgetary constraints.
