1772 Meetinghouse Restoration Committee Meeting August 7, 2017 New Durham Public Library

Call to Order - Chairperson George Gale called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

Business -

Fundraising/Grants/CRF

LCHIP: George reported that he completed all of the documentation necessary to demonstrate due diligence to LCHIP. He said Dijit Taylor's email regarding his work was positive. George will deliver the materials to LCHIP on Wednesday, Aug. 9, 2017.

George suggested meeting with the Board of Selectmen on site, and a date of Saturday, Aug. 26, 2017 was proposed. He suggested the stewardship plan be included in the Building Inspector's job description. He said that TA Scott Kinmond indicated the plan for when the building is restored looks fine. Clayton Randall suggested a committee representative always be involved.

George submitted ideas to involve community leaders in the overall plan.

Construction/Maintenance

Items to be brought up to the Board of Selectmen - The following were discussed: establishing a Maintenance CRF, cemetery upkeep, installing a new power panel, tax credits for vendors who provide services inexpensively, necessary tree trimming and removal, relocation of power lines, a new sign over the front door of the building, stone steps replacement, road repair, and hilltop grading.

Planning

The Committee needs to find out what needs to be done and how much it will cost. George said we could jump off of some details in the Historic Building Assessment, and we have the color-coded frame plan crafted by Aron Sturgis. An issue to decide is to fly out the roof or fix it in place. Flying it out was the preferred option when the repairs were to be a Timber Framers' Guild project. The Committee discussed the 50% matching assessment grants offered by the New Hampshire Preservation Alliance. George said we need to get the new field agent on site. George said he would check with Bob Craycraft about help with mapping. Cathy Allyn said she could contact Dr. Yap at Plymouth State to see if a student could do the drawings.
