Call to Order: Co-chairperson Cathy Allyn called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Update:

Clean-up - The Committee scheduled a clean up day for May 18, 2019 at 7:30 a.m. Discussion ensued regarding the status of the wall, in order to plant day lilies along it.
