Meeting with Jonathan Halle, WarrenStreet Coop

Bob reviewed highlights of the meeting.

- WarrenStreet will not participate if the BOS insist on using the RBF process
 - QBS is their preference
- a project manager would be responsible for acquiring bids, etc.
 - they would work for the BOS
- alternative funding is available thru a block grant
 - · \$500,000 \$750,000
 - provide them with an outline of our application by the end of August for feedback
- survey of the 6.9 acre lot is needed
 - include building, pound, cemetary, vernal pool
- we need National Registry approval through the Park Service

250th Heritage plaques

- there were no gold donors
- have one silver donor plaque for 10 donors
 - 9x12 inches with 12 plates (approx. \$110 + \$7 per plate)

Apple Bake-Off

Sue presented a menu of of suggestions for implementing the bake-off. Final choices are:

- any recipe whose ingredients are mainly apples
- 1st and 2nd place awarded in each class
- winners determined by vote of the public
- cost to vote: \$10 per adult children may sample parents portion and advise them how to vote.
