Update from the CLF case-summary judgement found in favor of State for release of phosphorus from sediment. Sediment cannot be considered a point source. There is no legal claim that the release of P from sediment is an additional discharge. However, CLF intends to bring the issue of cleaning up the river after the hatchery waste water is fixed again as a separate issue and they are not prevented in doing this. Trial set for October 2020.
