- <u>Swim Lessons</u> begin on 6/26. Two three-week sessions are scheduled for ages 4 and older. Registration is available online. Lessons for 3 and under will be available in late July.
- <u>Ball fields</u> mowing has been assigned to Alli who has been trained on the mower.
