Chair Swenson read 28 the Board of Selectmen's response into the record. 29 30 Chair Swenson stated although the Town Finance Department and Interim Town Administrator 31 have attempted to resolve the issue, Copple Crown Village District does not appear to be able to 32 33 submit the required information in a timely manner to the New Hampshire Department of Revenue Administration in time for a tax rate decision. It is highly likely that the Town will 34 need to obtain a Tax Anticipation Note (TAN). Chair Swenson requested Interim Town 35 Administrator Chase begin the process for obtaining the TAN. 36 37 MOTION: Due to Copple Crown Village District being unable to provide the necessary 38 39 information to NH DRA, the Town approves the application and requests the Town Administrator and Finance Manager prepare the necessary paperwork for the Tax 40 Anticipation Note (TAN) with the amount to be determined based on various payments due 41 42 including Strafford County and other similar payments until the Town can set the tax rate 43 and tax bills sent out with sufficient revenue to repay the TAN. Motion by Chair Swenson. Second by Vice Chair Veisel. 44 45 **Discussion:** Selectman DeCoff asked if they know what the interest rates would be. Interim Town Administrator Chase stated they have done some research and at this time it is estimated to

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- be about 6%. It is unclear when Copple Crown will have the necessary information submitted to
