This exemption shall 34 extend to any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine, or other levy, if based 35 on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant; (1) Consideration of legal advice provided by legal counsel, 36 either in writing orally, to one of more members of the public body, even where legal counsel is not 37 present. 38 Selectman Veisel seconded the motion.
