Town boat ramp on Shaws needs to be remediated by the DPW and \$4k comes from the CRF conceptual design requests made with 3 companies. Town Engineer emailed that it would be more like \$10K. Select Board notified that \$3-4K may not be sufficient. Awaiting other responses.

 - a. Meeting with Road Agent, PWD email sent that we are disappointed again for not showing up as scheduled and would like to work with them. Town Interim Administrator suggested we go through her in the future.
 - b. Met with the Board of Selectmen on March? 19, 2024. Due to the elevated chloride in the tribs and ponds in New Durham, we recommended the people who drive snow plows on North or South Shore Road, Merrymeeting Road, Birch Hill Road and Kings Hwy are <u>required</u> to take a course from the UNH Technology Transfer Program on salt use. Town Administrator stated they do this, but 2 have not taken the course as of yet and she is unsure of the contracted snowplower on Kings Hwy.
