CALL TO ORDER

Chair Jarvis called the meeting to order at 5:07 PM.

The members of the Zoning Board of Adjustment walked the property at 43 Meaders Point Road.

- The property has 16% slopes, part of which included a steep path from the parking area to the structure. This path is deteriorating, is unsafe and needs to be replaced.
- 245 square feet of new space will be added
- Currently there are two bedrooms on the second floor.
 - One bedroom will be made into a den.
 - o A new bedroom will be added to the first floor.
- Currently there are one and a half bathrooms. After construction there will be two full bathrooms.
- Three of the individuals using the home have medical issues making it difficult for them to access the second floor.
- No Conditional Use Permit (CUP) is required. If more of the driveway is made pervious a CUP will be required.
- In order to further reduce the impervious coverage, there was discussion regarding removing the storage shed as there may be additional storage area in the new basement.
- There are significant numbers of trees with caliper of 12 inches and larger throughout the site. There are many trees between the existing house and existing parking area.
- A new bedroom will be added to the 1st floor in configuration with an extension along the roadside of the house for an improved entry.
- Existing house sonnet tubes are deteriorating. Will be replaced with a full frost proof foundation.
